Can I join more than one CCA?

Yes.

Many of our learners participate in two or more CCAs. The key to balancing studies and CCAs is good time management.

CCAs are a great way to have an enriching and balanced student life. They allow you to meet peers with the same interests, as you come together to develop your talents, interests, and skills.

In addition, we have something called the Student Life Academy. It **complements** CCAs. SLA offers a series of enrichment activities like Lunchtime Talks, Learn to Play series, Life Skills Workshops, Projects-by-Students-for-Students, E-Tastic videos/podcasts, and Learning Journeys, all of which are open to anyone to participate in.

Can I join a CCA mid-semester?

Yes and no, it depends on the nature of each CCA.

While some CCAs require learners to go through a selection process such as auditions, interviews, try-outs, others welcome members for ad-hoc projects and events.

However, CCA points will only be awarded to members who fulfill the minimum attendance of 80% or more.
