



NYP Academic Integrity Policy

Academic Integrity Policy

1. NYP's Academic Integrity Policy had been revised and updated with effect from 15 Apr 2024 and it covers all the learning units in PET, CET and PFP and all the assessments in NYP.
2. The following acts describe the offences related to Academic Integrity:
 - Cheating: Attempting to get or provide unauthorised assistance in an assessment including;
 - Copying another candidate's answers
 - Providing or assisting another candidate with answers
 - Referring to documents that are not allowed in the assessment
 - Referring to information kept in electronic or mobile devices that are not allowed in the assessment
 - Using any devices (such as mobile phones, programmable calculators, smart devices, etc.) when they are not allowed in the assessment
 - Fabrication: Falsifying data, information or citations;
 - Deception: Asking another person to complete the work that the candidate is supposed to do; and
 - Plagiarism: Taking and using the whole or any part of ideas, words or works of others, including contents generated by AI tools and passing it off as one's own work without acknowledgement of the original source.

Summary of Policy Statements and Penalties

3. The new policy will differentiate first, second and third-time offenders as follows:

Policy Statement	Penalties
First Offence A candidate who, after due disciplinary process, is found to have committed an act that contravenes academic integrity in any assessment of a module/competency unit shall fail the module/competency unit. The candidate shall be given an 'F' grade for the module/competency unit with a corresponding grade point of 0 (0 mark).	A student who is caught cheating in any assessment (that affects the module/competency unit score/grade) shall fail the module/competency unit . It doesn't matter what the weightage of the assessment is.
Second Offence A candidate who, after due disciplinary process is, found to have committed an act that contravenes academic integrity for a second time in his/her candidature in NYP shall be deemed to have failed all the registered (but uncompleted) modules/competency units. The candidate	A student who is caught cheating for a second time shall fail all the modules/competency units in the semester (PET students) or in the case of a CET student, any other

shall be given an 'F' grade for these modules/competency units with a corresponding grade point of 0 (0 mark).	modules/competency units registered in the system.
<p>Third Offence</p> <p>A candidate who, after due disciplinary process is, found to have committed an act that contravenes academic integrity for a third time in his/her candidature in NYP shall have his/her candidature terminated. He/she shall be deemed to have failed all the registered (but uncompleted) modules/competency units. The candidate shall be given an 'F' grade for these modules/competency units with a corresponding grade point of 0 (0 mark).</p>	<p>A student who is caught cheating for the third time shall be expelled from NYP.</p>
