

LifePRO Unit Framework for SEG, SHSS & SIT Year 3 learners in AY2026

Launch of LifePRO

From April 2026, NYP's General Studies Module (GSM) framework will transition to the **LifePRO Unit (LPU) Framework** with modules renamed as LifePRO Units.

LPUs are essentially the existing GSMs under a new framework and name, with the same goal of supporting your holistic development beyond your domain studies.



Why are we transitioning from GSM to LifePRO?

- **More flexibility for your learning journey**

The GSM structure has been streamlined allowing you to explore opportunities under our new initiative, **Go Beyond** through the Professional, International and University pathways.

- **Stronger focus on real-world skills**

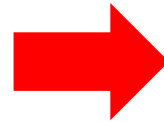
LifePRO places greater emphasis on developing LifeSkills that complement your diploma studies.

What this means to you?

There are no changes to your curriculum or requirements.

This is purely a name change from **GSM to LifePRO Units**.

Your existing modules, credits and graduation requirements **remain the same**.

 - Understanding Singapore 1 (1 credit)

- **3 Prescribed LPUs**
 - Personal Career Strategy 2 (1 credit)
 - Respect in Relationships (1 credit)
 - Understanding Singapore 2 (1 credit)
- **1 Elective LPU**

Year 3

- **2 Elective LPUs**

LPU Requirements for Year 3 Learners

- Year 3 learners will take :

2 Elective LPUs in either semester

- Please check with your Course Manager if you are unsure about the number of LPUs that you need to fulfill

- All LPU lessons will **commence in Week 2** and **end by Week 16**
- Please refer to the table below for the elective LPU time slots

2. LPU Selection Process

LPU Selection Process

- All Year 3 learners will pre-select a certain number of your desired elective LPU choices by using the **GENESSYS** Selection System)
- You will be registered for learning units by GENESSYS, subject to the following factors:
 - The **order of your choices**
 - **Demand and availability** of the learning units that you have selected
 - Your **average nett LPU attendance** percentage, if you have selected an over-subscribed learning unit

How Is Your LPU Attendance Rate Considered For Learning Unit Allocation?

- If a particular LPU is over-subscribed (i.e. more applicants than vacancies), GENESSYS will look at each learner's **average nett LPU attendance percentage for the last 2 semesters** to determine allocation
- A learner with a higher average LPU attendance rate for the last 2 semesters will be given priority for the learning unit versus another learner with a lower attendance rate
- Only your nett LPU attendance percentage will be considered (you are not penalised for missed lessons due to valid reasons)
- It is therefore important for you to attend your LPU classes regularly to maintain a good attendance rate, which gives you a higher chance of securing your choice LPU for future semesters' selection exercises

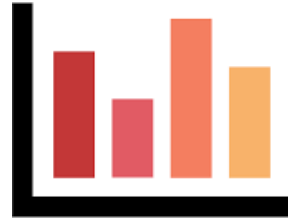
Over-subscribed learning units – How it Works

their 1st choice



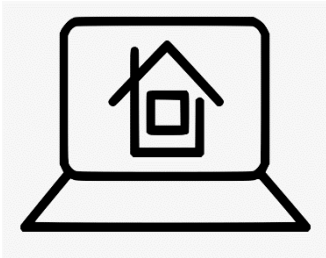
- System will compare the average LPU attendance % for each of the 30 learners
- System will give the 20 places to learners who have the best attendance rates



If there is a tie for the last few places due to similar attendance %, the system will randomly allocate the remaining places

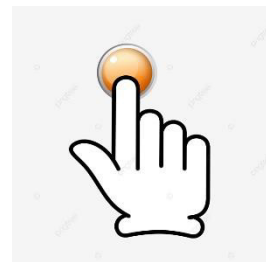



3. How to Select LPUs

Access MyNYP Portal

- Once the selection exercise is open, log into the student portal - **myNYP Portal** - with your log-in ID and password

Submit Your Choices

- Your choices are considered successfully “submitted” once they are **saved**.
- After submitting, you can still log into GENESSYS to make changes to your previous selection **before the closing date** of the selection exercise, after which all choices are considered **final**.

4. Important Information for LPU Selection

Modules are grouped into the following three categories

| Group | Learning units offered by | No. of Choices you must make per group for choices 1 to 9 |
|-------|--|---|
| 1 | CILS (Centre for Innovation & Life Skills) | 2 |
| 2 | SBM, SEG and SAS | 4 |
| 3 | SDM, SHSS and SIT | 3 |

For choices 10, 11 and 12, you can select learning units from any of the three groups.

- You are given a total of **12 choices** for submission.
- For **choices 1 to 9**, you are required to select two learning units from Group 1, four learning units from Group 2 and three learning units from Group 3 in any order (see table above).
- **Last 3 choices (Choice 10, 11 & 12)** can be from any group
- Please refer to LPU portal in myNYP Portal for more information on LPU learning units and number of vacancies offered.

LPUs with Pre-Requisite Conditions

Please note that you must meet the pre-requisites for the following learning units:

Year 2 learning units

- Introduction to Malay Language
(must not have taken Malay previously)
- Business Chinese
(must have achieved a grade of 1-6 in 'N' or 'O'-Level Chinese)

Year 3 learning units

- Introduction to French/German/Japanese/Korean Language 2
(must have passed the relevant level 1 language learning units in Year 2)

Learners who have been allocated a learning unit but found not to have satisfy the pre-requisite may be reassigned to another LPU

LPUs with Pre-Requisite Conditions

Foreign Language Optional Electives (FLOE)

If you have taken and passed FLOE Level 1, then you will not be allowed to take LPU Language 1 or LPU Language 2 as both these learning units share similar content as the FLOE 1 learning unit.

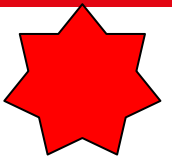
Example:

1. You have taken and passed Japanese Language Optional Elective 1
2. During LPU selection, the system will not allow you to take the following:
 - Intro to Japanese Language 1 (for Year 2 learners)
 - Intro to Japanese Language 2 (for Year 3 learners)

Making Your Submission

- Please ensure that you **complete all 12 choices** before submission.
- After submitting, you can still log into GENESSYS to make changes to your selection before the closing date of the selection exercise, after which all choices are considered final.
- Do note that due to overwhelming demand for some learning units, learners may not be guaranteed their top choices.

Important Considerations When Selecting Your LPUs



- Select and prioritise your learning units based on interest
- Takes note of learning units that have pre-requisites when making your selection
- Spread your selection across the various time slots to maximise your chances of getting the learning units that you want, especially if you are required to take 2 LPUs

For example, you selected only the 3pm time slots for all your 12 choices.

Implications:

Competition for these time slots may be high and you may end up not getting any LPU of your choice. GENESSYS may then allocate you to any available LPU outside of your selection.

Instead, you should select a mixture of time slots – 3pm and 4pm – for learning units that you are interested in to maximise your chances of getting a place.

Posting Results

- Allocation will be confirmed around a week before semester starts
- Please check and print your timetable to view the LPUs that have been allocated to you
- If there is any discrepancy in your LPU timetable, please inform your Personal Mentor or Course Manager


