

REQUEST FOR CUSTOMISED STUDY PATHWAY (NON-ACADEMIC)

- 1. This form is for full-time students with valid and acceptable reasons to request for customised study pathway (CSP) so that they can better manage their study load.
- 2. You are advised to discuss this with your Course Manager, Course Coordinator or Personal Mentor before submitting the request.
- 3. Please scan and email the completed form with supporting documents to your Course Manager or Course Coordinator.
- 4. The completed form is to be submitted at least 2 weeks before the start of the next semester.
- 5. You may be required to submit supporting documents, and these should be submitted within 5 working days upon request.
- 6. Once an application is approved, the CSP will only take effect from next semester. Full fees will be charged for the first 6 semesters, and half fees will be charged if you take on less than half the normal academic load for subsequent semesters.
- 7. Students are allowed to apply for up to 2 consecutive semesters of CSP for side activities.
- 8. Students can take up to a maximum period of 6 years to complete the course of study. However, do take note that full unsubsidised fees apply upon utilization of 10 semesters of Tuition grant.
