

TUITION GRANT (TG) APPLICATION PROCESS

Be Ready for TG Application!

1 PRE-APPLICATION

Complete these 2 pre-application steps, (a) & (b) as soon as you have obtained your Student's Pass.

Note: You will need approximately 2 weeks to complete this process.

2 TG BRIEFING

Watch the TG briefing video (link to be provided by your institution).

Complete the self-assessment quiz after watching.

Review the embedded FAQ document with answers to common questions.

TG CLINIC

For additional questions not covered in the video or FAQ, attend TG Clinic hosted by the institution.

Come prepared by reading all provided materials and information beforehand.

3 DECLARATION FORM

Submit the compulsory declaration form, acknowledging your understanding of TG obligations and agreeing to seek employment with a Singapore entity to fulfil your 3-year bond.

Explain to your sureties on the TG obligations and implications for failing to fulfil obligations.

- Failure to submit the declaration by the deadline may result in rejection or delayed processing of your TG application, which will result in you paying non-subsidised tuition fees.

4 APPLY FOR TG

Apply for TG during the application window.

It is your responsibility to ensure that you and your sureties' particulars and email addresses are submitted accurately.

- Failure to apply for TG by the deadline will result in you paying non-subsidised tuition fees.

Application details such as application dates, portal URL and user guide to be provided by your institution.

(a) Get Singpass Ready!

i. Obtain Student's Pass

Provide biometric data at ICA Singapore
Allow 5 working days for info to sync with Singpass

ii. Register for Singpass

Use your digital Student's Pass for registration

iii. Activate Singpass (Set up 2FA)

Get a Singapore-registered mobile number ready earlier, as you will need it to receive a One-Time Pin (OTP) to complete Singpass activation

Alternatively, PIN-mailer (not recommended) can be requested but will take 7 working days to reach a Singapore address



(b) Gather Sureties' Information & Identification Documents (ID)!

Obtain all required information for yourself and your sureties in advance.

Keep a softcopy of your own and sureties' Identification Document (ID) that contains photo and home country address, and supporting documents, if required

5 SIGN TGA (TG AGREEMENT)

After submitting your application, you and your sureties will receive email notifications to sign the TGA online.

It is your responsibility to monitor progress and remind your sureties to complete the signing process.

- Failure to complete the signing by the deadline will result in you paying non-subsidised tuition fees.

6 CHECK TG STATUS

You will be notified via email upon completing the signing process successfully.

Login to the portal to verify your TG status 3 weeks after you have completed the signing.
