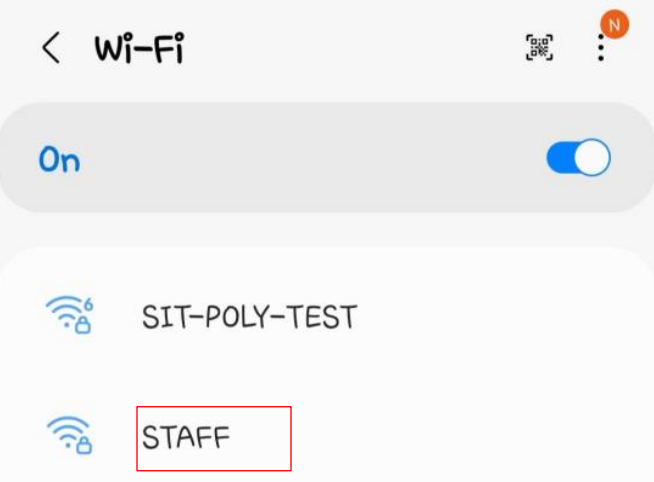

1. Configuration Guide for Android Phone

*Based on the Android phone, different Brand and Model may differ, here we are using Samsung Z Flip 3 as test model.

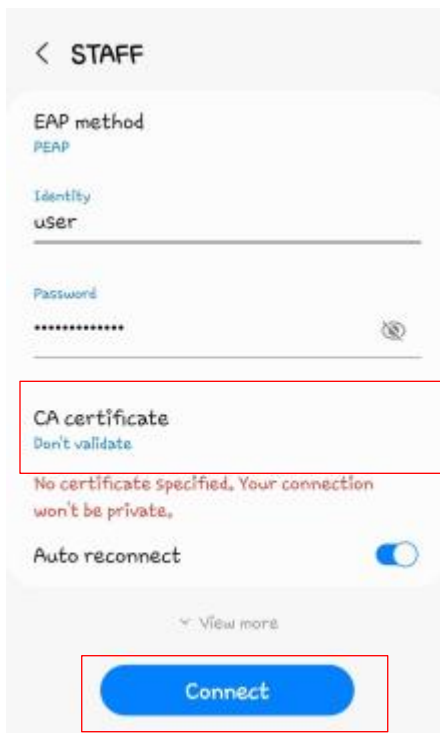
STAFF credential Use Windows Login name and password.

<p>1. Forget SSID if you have connected before.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• From Setting tap Connections then tap WiFi.• Under Available Network selects SSID “STAFF”, tap and hold till user sees Forget network option.• Tap “Forget network” to remove “STAFF” SSID. 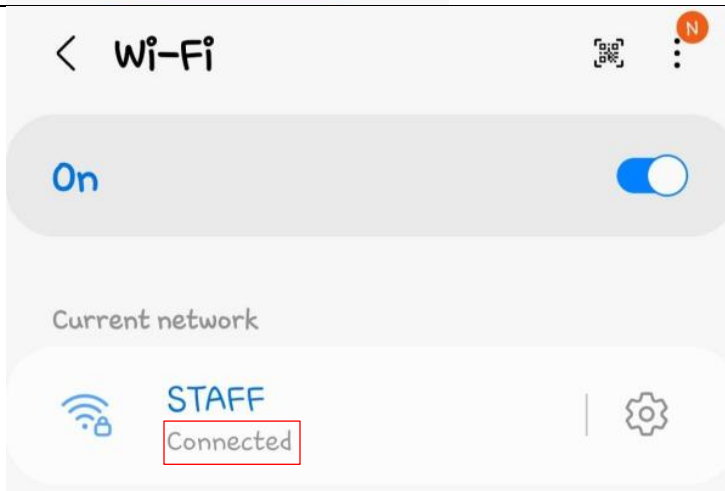
3. Connect to SSID

- Once user selected SSID, under Identity that would be user's username follow by user's password.
- Under CA certificate user needs to select "**Select certificates**" option and select "**Don't validate**". (Note: If no certificate under CA certificate is selected. Connect button will be inactive)
- Staff taps "**Connect**" button.



4. WiFi Connected Successfully

- When user is successfully connected to WiFi, it will show connected under SSID name in Current network.



Troubleshooting Tips

Forget a network, so Android Phone doesn't join it automatically: Choose WiFi and tap next to a network you've joined before.

Then tap "Forget this Network." Reset the network settings on iPhone: Choose Settings > General > Reset > Reset Network Settings.

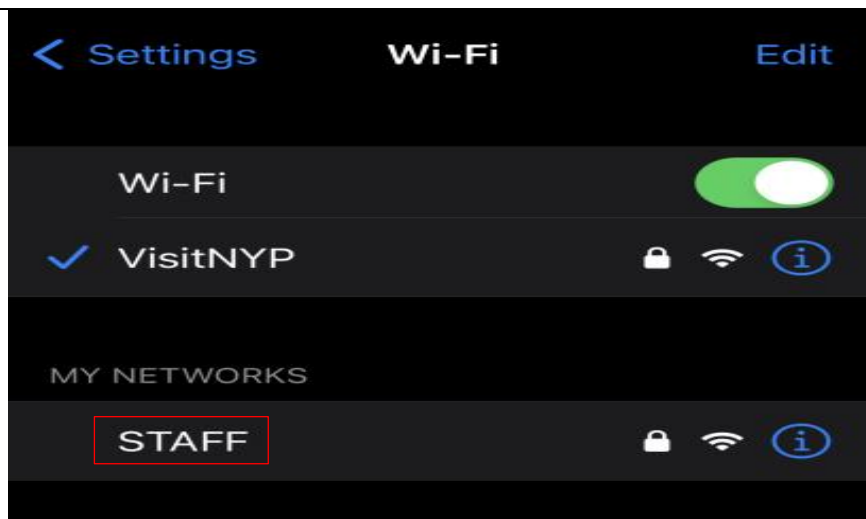

*Screen base on iOS 16.1.1 and above installed, another version of iOS may differ.


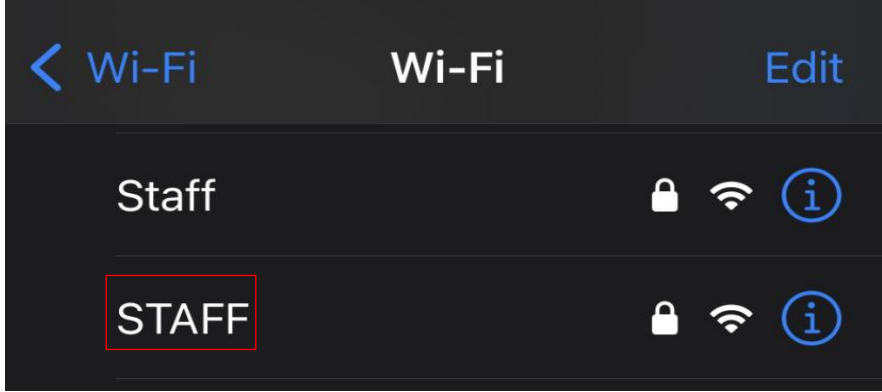
STAFF credential Use Windows Login name and password.

1. Forget SSID if you have connected before.

- From your Home screen, go to Settings > WiFi
- Under MY NETWORKS tap on ⓘ for more information
- Tap **“Forget this Network”**.
- When prompt, user taps **“Forget”**



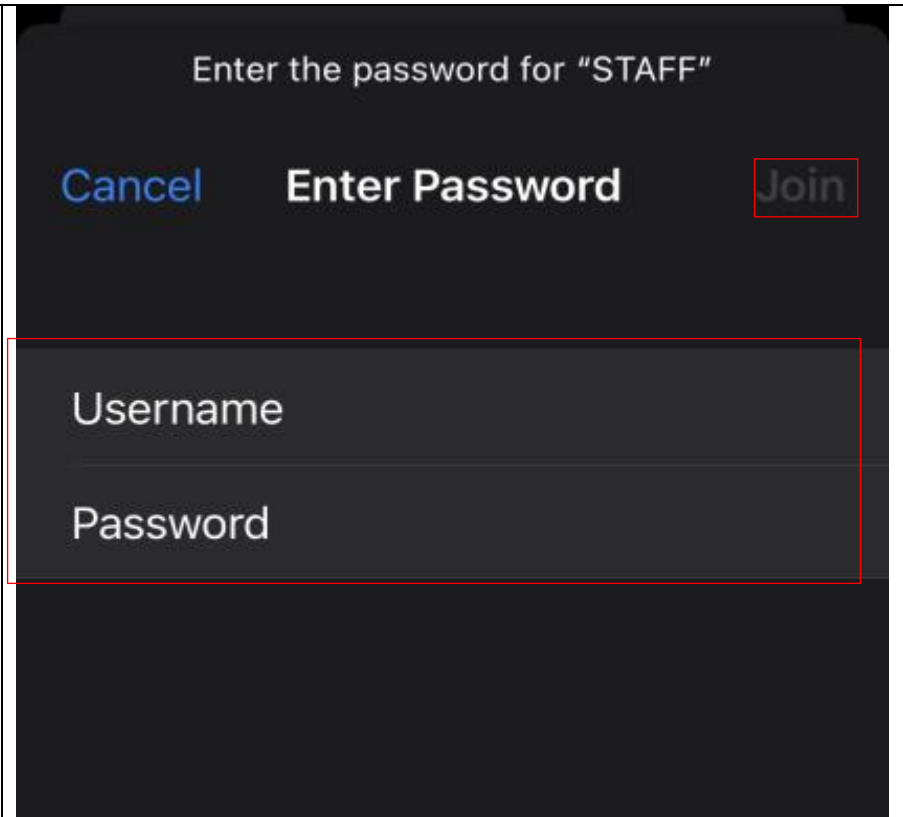

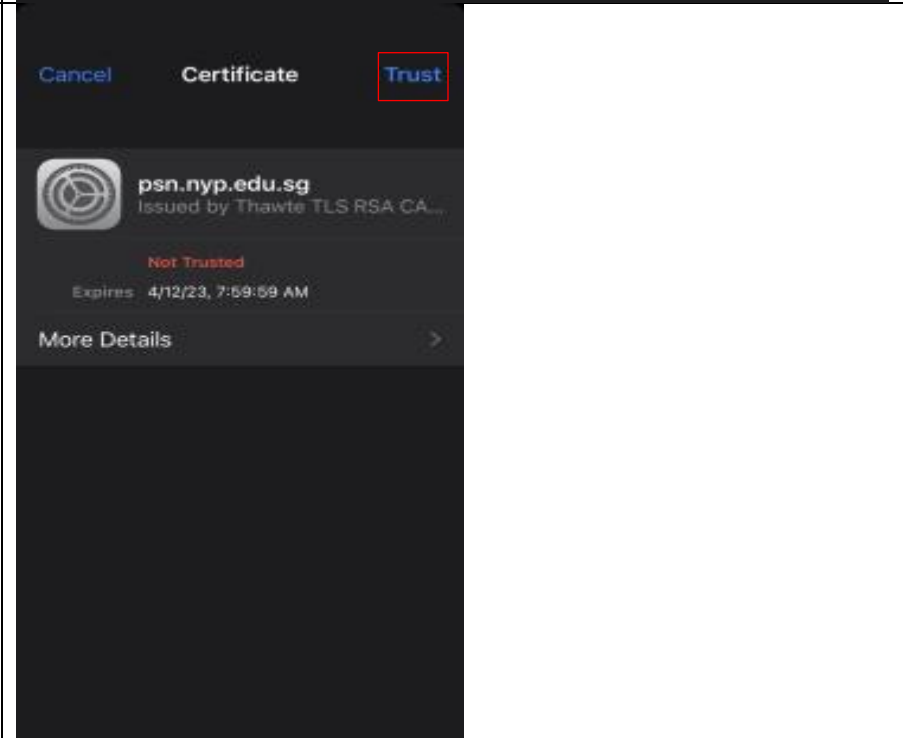
3. Enter User Credentials

4. Trust Certificate

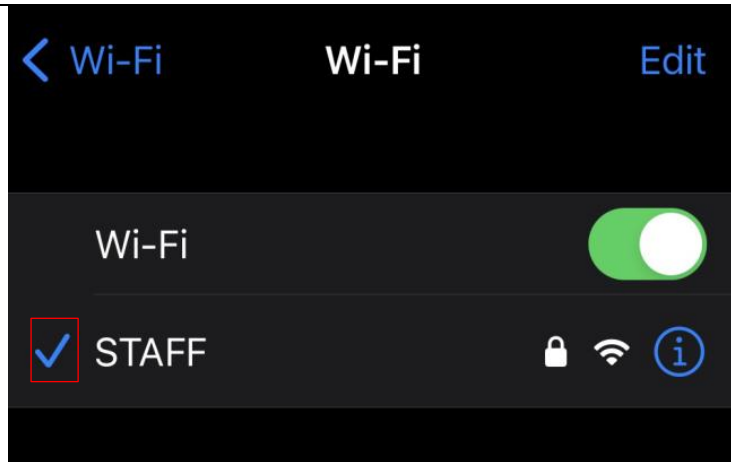
- After input user credentials and click join, will prompt a certificate warning, Click **Trust** at the top right-hand corner.

- After you join a network, you'll see a tick next to the network.





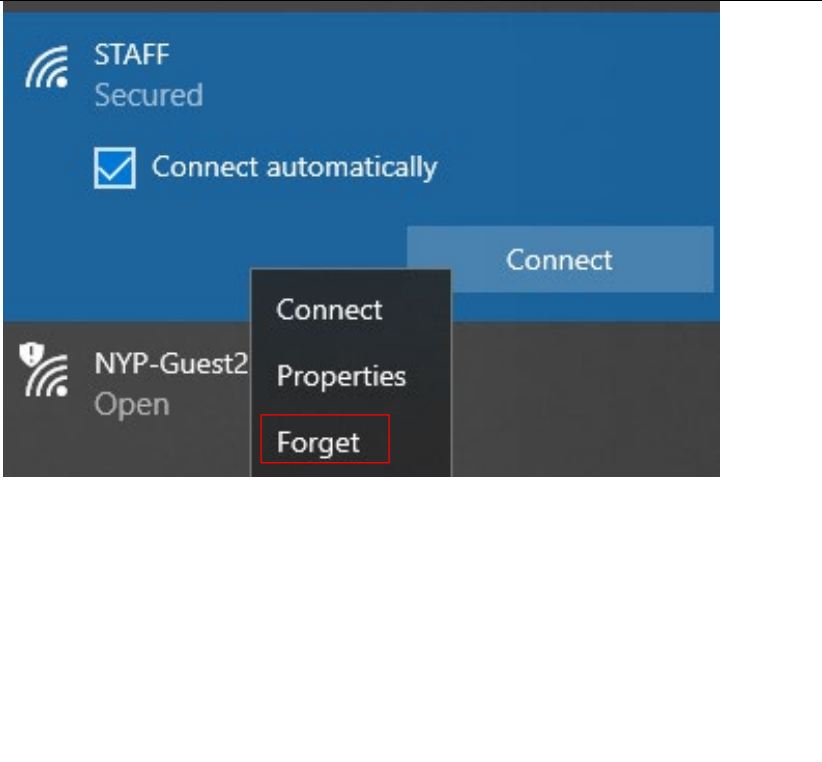


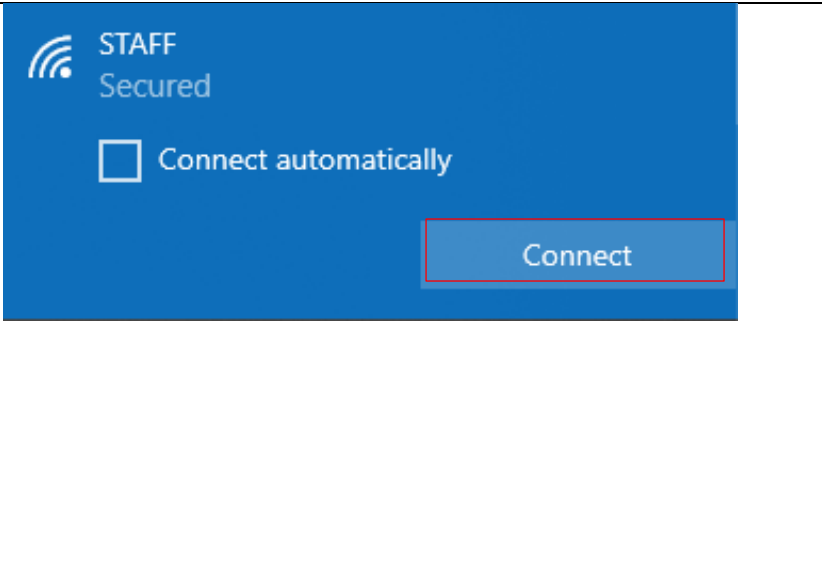
Troubleshooting Tips

1. Forget a network, so iPhone doesn't join it automatically: Choose Wi-Fi and tap next to a network you've joined before. Then tap "Forget this Network."
2. Reset the network settings on iPhone: Choose Settings > General > Reset > Reset Network Settings.

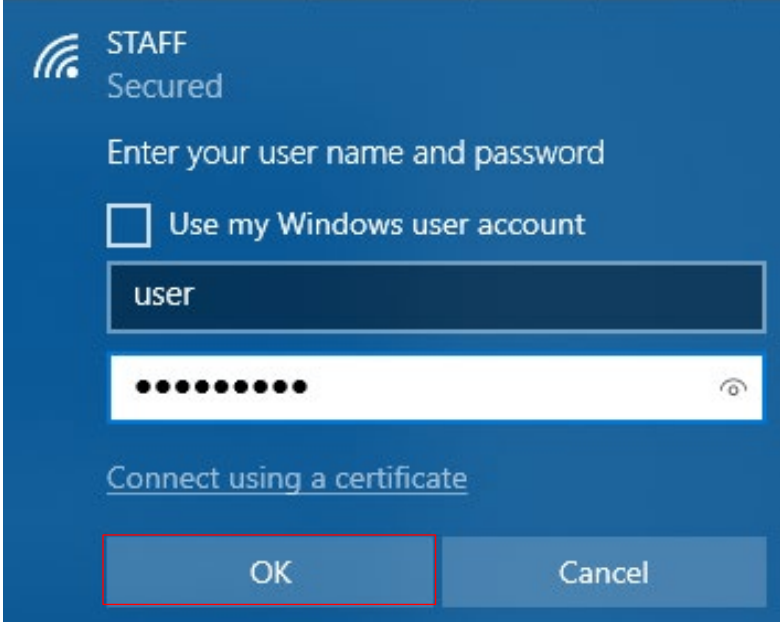
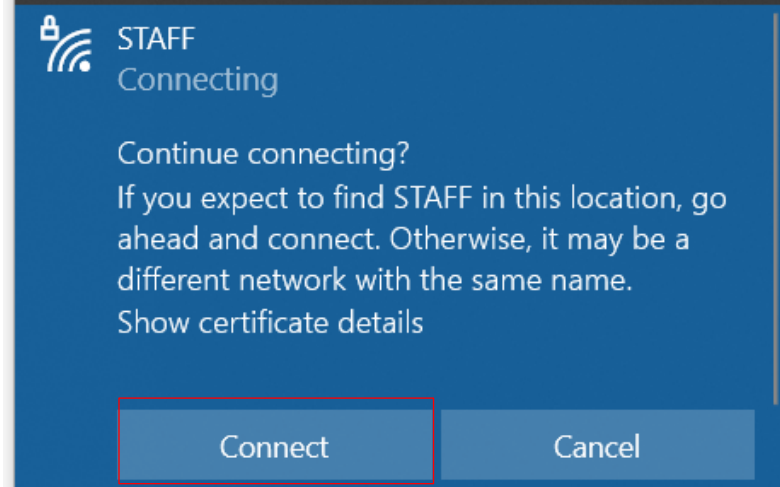
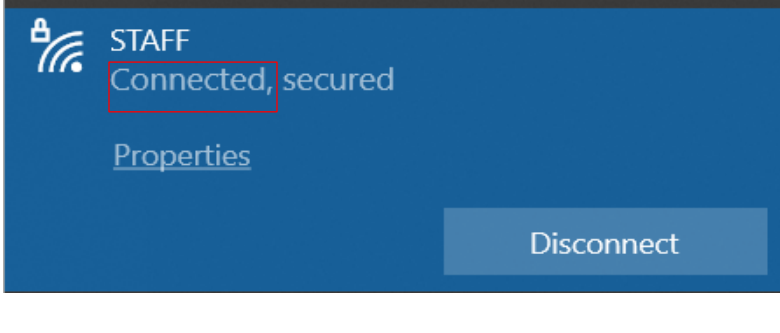
3. Configuration Guide for Windows 10

When you are within range of the wireless Access Point and your wireless network radio enabled, Windows will display a pop-up message on your taskbar

STAFF credential Use Windows Login name and password.

<p>1. Forget SSID if you have connected before.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Click  at lower-right corner to open the WiFi list. (Note: If LAN cable is connected before connected to SSID, the icon will gets replaced to this )• Selected and right click "STAFF" and click "Forget" (Note: Forget option will only available to existing user which connected to STAFF SSID before.)	
<p>2. Select STAFF SSID</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• When user not connected to any SSID.• Select Click  at lower-right corner task bar. It will automatically search for available WiFi networks (Note: If LAN cable is connected before connected to SSID, the icon will gets replaced to this )

<ul style="list-style-type: none">Select the SSID: STAFF from WiFi list and click “Connect”	
<p>3. Connect to SSID</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Type in login username and password.Click “OK” <p>(Note: OK button will be inactive until user types in login credential.)</p>	 <p>STAFF Secured</p> <p>Enter your user name and password</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Use my Windows user account</p> <p>user</p> <p>.....</p> <p>Connect using a certificate</p> <p>OK Cancel</p>
<p>4. Trust Certificate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">After user clicks “OK”, it will prompt a certificate warning, then click “Connect”	 <p>STAFF Connecting</p> <p>Continue connecting? If you expect to find STAFF in this location, go ahead and connect. Otherwise, it may be a different network with the same name. Show certificate details</p> <p>Connect Cancel</p>
<p>5. Connected successfully</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">After user joins a network successfully, user will see Connected at the bottom of SSID.	 <p>STAFF Connected, secured</p> <p>Properties</p> <p>Disconnect</p>
